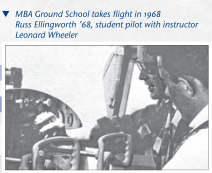

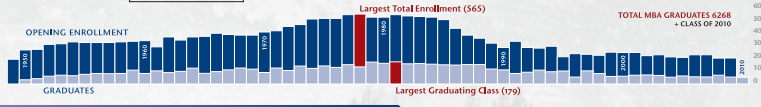
Commercial laundry opened

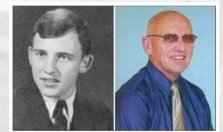

CAMP McQUAIDE

1930 The California National Guard's 250th Coast Artillery Regiment is established

1930 Military documentation begins listing the Capitola training camp as Camp McQuaide. Camp is named in honor of a Catholic chaplain, Father Joseph P. McQuaide, for the National Guard. Camp McQuaide was the only military reservation so named

1940 The California National Guard's 250th Coast Artillery Regiment is moved to San Andreas Rd, Watsonville

1940 The Coast Artillery Regiment is changed to the Coast Artillery Replacement Training Center

1940 Camp McQuaide is converted to the West Coast Processing Center

1940 Camp McQuaide is placed in the category of surplus. The Caretaking Detachment is discontinued as of July 30, 1947

1948 Grunke Family first civilians to live on the campus
